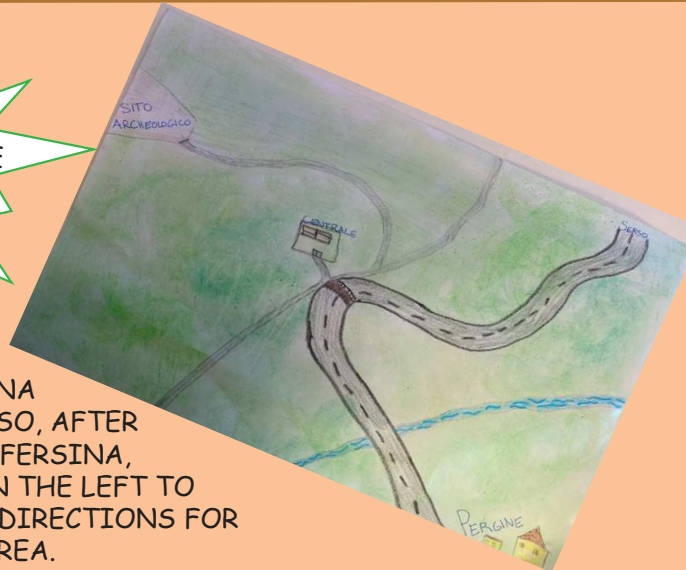

FROM PERGINE VALSUGANA
 HEADING TOWARDS SERSO, AFTER
 THE BRIDGE OVER RIVER FERSINA,
 TAKE THE FIRST EXIT ON THE LEFT TO
 CENTRALE. FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR
 THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREA.
 EXCAVATIONS HAVE UNEARTHED THE REMAINS OF A
 VILLAGE BUILT BY THE RHAETIC PEOPLE, AN ALPINE
 POPULATION THAT LIVED IN THIS AREA BETWEEN THE 6TH
 AND 1ST CENTURIES BC.

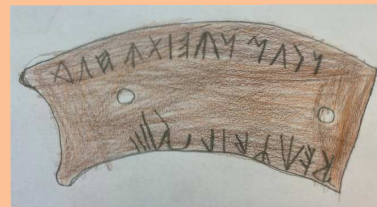
THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL

 REACH A CROSSROADS WITH
 THE INDICATION: ZONE A
 AND ZONE B
 IN ZONE A, YOU CAN SEE THE
 REMAINS OF A HOUSE.
 IN ZONE B, YOU CAN SEE THE
 REMAINS OF THREE HOUSES.
 ALL HOMES WERE PARTIALLY
 UNDERGROUND.

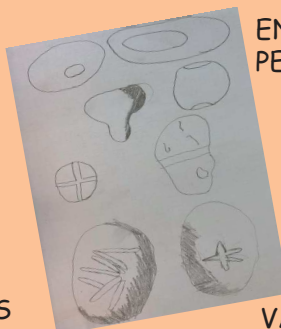

ENGRAVED BONE HANDLES



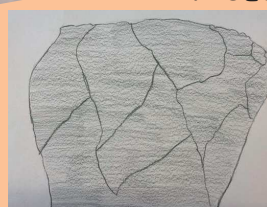

HERE YOU FIND THE REMAINS OF A HOUSE WITH AN IRREGULAR SHAPE. THE WALLS ARE MADE OF ROCK AND STONES WITHOUT MORTAR. YOU CAN SEE AN ENTRANCE CORRIDOR.

IT IS IRREGULARLY SHAPED AND HAS AN ENTRANCE. THE WALLS WERE HALF STONE AND HALF WOOD. PERHAPS THE RHAETIC PEOPLE FLED THE HOUSE BECAUSE OF A FIRE.

IT IS LARGE AND HAS TWO ENTRANCES. ARCHAEOLOGISTS HAVE FOUND MANY ARTIFACTS, INCLUDING SOME OBJECTS WITH ENGRAVINGS.

IT WAS CHANGED OVER TIME. IT WAS DESTROYED BY FIRE AND REBUILT IN A SMALLER SIZE.
